

American Headache Society Guidelines Development Completing the Justification Statement

- 1. The Justification Statement should be approximately one double-spaced page in length
- 2. It should outline the problem to be addressed and include examples of specific clinical questions that could be answered in the guideline
- 3. Because availability of evidence is crucial to the project's success, it is essential to include sample citations that represent the best available evidence on the topic
- 4. The Justification Statement should include the following factors.
 - a. Relevance to Headache Medicine
 - b. Prevalence of condition
 - c. Health impact of condition for the individual
 - d. Socioeconomic impact
 - e. Extent of practice variation
 - f. Quality of available evidence
 - g. External constraints on practice (e/g/ access issues, reimbursement issues, paucity of data for setting policy, health policy gaps, resource constraints)
 - h. Urgency for evaluation of new therapy or technology
 - i. Potential for significant benefit, risk or abuse
 - j. List of content expert contributors
