



2021 Harold G. Wolff Lecture Award

The American Headache Society® (AHS) announces the availability of the 2021 Harold G. Wolff Lecture Award. This award is for the best paper on headache, head or face pain, or the nature of pain itself. The recipient of this award will receive \$10,000 plus complimentary meeting registration and expenses for travel, hotel accommodations and meals for the 63rd Annual Scientific Meeting, being held June 3-6, 2021 in Orlando, FL. The recipient will be invited to present the paper at this meeting.

To be considered for this award, applicants must submit an abstract for consideration at the 63rd Annual Scientific Meeting using the online abstract submission form by **Sunday, January 31, 2021 at 11:59 pm HST.**

In addition, a manuscript should be submitted to the AHS Executive Offices no later than Monday March 1, 2021 and should be prepared in accordance with "[Author Guidelines](#)" as published in the journal *Headache*®. Please note papers submitted for the Wolff Award should be sent only to the AHS Executive Offices, and not submitted to *Headache* via Manuscript Central until after the recipient has been announced. All entries will be reviewed by the Editorial Board who will reach out to authors they would like to encourage to submit formally via Manuscript Central. The winning manuscript will become the property of *Headache* and will be fast tracked for publication in a 2021 issue of *Headache*.
